

DUAL CREDIT PROGRAM

The dual credit program offered in Crandall allows qualifying students to earn high school credit and college hours simultaneously. Dual credit enrollment in a variety of courses is offered to students through Trinity Valley Community College. Students must obtain approval by consulting with their counselors prior to enrolling in dual credit courses at Trinity Valley Community College, and they must also take the Texas Higher Education Assessment ® (THEA®) test. The community colleges may charge tuition and fees for dual credit courses. Each course taken for dual credit may count for one of the four advanced measures in the Distinguished Achievement Program.
