

## **District Wide Educational Improvement Committee**

The District Wide Educational Improvement Committee (DWEIC) is an elected committee of professional staff, parents, community members, and business representatives. The purpose of the committee is to advise the superintendent in establishing and reviewing the District's educational goals, objectives, and major district wide instructional programs. The composition of the committee includes two special program teachers (e.g. special education, ESL, gifted and talented, compensatory education, etc...), two regular program teachers from each campus, two nonteaching, campus-based, professional employees (e.g. counselors, nurses, administrators/directors) two parents, and one community member.

The committee usually meets on the third Tuesday of each month. Members can request items to be placed on the agenda for discussion with prior written request to the superintendent. Agenda items must address the broad based, instructional goals and objectives of the district that address one of the following areas: 1) student achievement, 2) curriculum, 3) use of technology/facilities or instruction, 4) student attendance, 5) discipline management, or 6) major district wide instruction programs.
