


RETURN TO LEARN

Health & Safety Protocols


CISD is implementing a variety of precautions and protocols for the 2021-22 school year in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. The following procedures and guidelines will be in effect as school begins. Visit https://www.crandall-isd.net/covid-19/healthsafetyprotocols for more information.



Campuses will work to ensure no one is treated differently because of their choice to wear, or not wear, a mask.



Staff and students will continue being encouraged to wash their hands frequently throughout the day. Covid Ambassadors will remain in place at each school for additional sanitization.




Campus visitors or volunteers will be allowed in the building only during scheduled school events and activities. Cafeterias will be closed to visitors during lunch hours the first six weeks.



Social distancing will be maintained when feasible, particularly in classrooms.




Staff and students are expected to selfscreen and stay home when they have signs of an infectious illness, and visit a healthcare provider for testing and care.



Staff and students with a confirmed case of COVID-19 in their household must quarantine for 10 days from the date symptoms began, or date of the positive test—unless fully vaccinated and showing no symptoms.



Students and staff may return from quarantine after 10 days of no symptoms.



If students or staff exhibit COVID-19 symptoms, test positive, or are exposed to someone who has tested positive, the child's campus nurse or staff member's immediate supervisor should be notified.




Campus nurses will perform contact tracing on confirmed cases and inform anyone who meets criteria for close-contact exposure.



Parents and staff will receive an email notification when there is a confirmed positive case on their campus or in their department.



Students must have a medical note on file documenting their history of seasonal allergies, asthma or symptoms that mimic COVID-19, or they will be considered COVID-19 related.



Students and staff are encouraged to bring their own reusable water bottle for use throughout the day and take water bottles home to be cleaned on a daily basis.

CISD will continue monitoring health updates from federal, state and local officials. The district's COVID-19 prevention strategies can adjust at any time based on recommendations from governing authorities.
